ORDER ADOPTING 2025 MONO COUNTY BAIL SCHEDULE
[Penal Code Sec. 1269b(c)]

Pursuant to Penal Code Section 1269b(c) it is the duty of the Superior Court Judges in each county to prepare, adopt, and annually revise a uniform countywide schedule of bail for all bailable felony offenses and for all misdemeanor offenses and infraction offenses except Vehicle Code infractions. In adopting a bail schedule for felony offenses, the judges shall consider the seriousness of the offense charged, and any aggravating or enhancing factors. The purpose of bail is to ensure an arrestee appears in court and to reduce the risk to public and victim safety. Article I, section 12 of the California Constitution entitles most arrestees to release on bail pending trial. The Constitution prohibits excessive bail, and the United States Supreme Court held in *United States v. Salerno* (1987) that "in our society liberty is the norm, and detention prior to trial is the carefully limited exception."

The purpose of this bail schedule is to set the amount of bail upon which a person arrested without a warrant may be released from custody prior to their first appearance in court, and to provide guidance for the setting of bail upon the issuance of an arrest warrant pursuant to Penal Code section 815a. Penal Code section 1270.1 prohibits the release of an arrestee on bail in an amount that is either more or less than the amount set in this bail schedule for the offenses listed in Penal Code Section 1270.1(a)(1)-(4) until a hearing has been held in open court. However, a judge or magistrate, pursuant to Penal Code Section 1269c, may with respect to a bailable felony or misdemeanor offense of violating a domestic violence restraining order, increase bail without a hearing, provided an oral or written declaration of facts justifying an increase in the bail amount is presented under penalty of perjury by a sworn peace officer.

At and after a defendant's first appearance in court, the amount of bail, if any, shall be in the amount fixed by the judge at the time of the appearance. (Penal Code § 1269b(b).) Any bail set at the time of an appearance in court shall comply with Penal Code Section 1275, with the law set forth in *In Re Humphrey* (2021) 11 Cal.5<sup>th</sup> 135, and Penal Code Section 1203.25(c) for probation violations.

When a defendant is booked on, or charged with, two or more offenses, bail shall be set in the amount for the charge having the highest bail. If the defendant is charged with crimes against multiple victims or on separate dates, or where separate sex acts have been alleged to have been committed against the same person, bail shall be set for each offense charged. Bail shall also be added for any applicable enhancement alleged.

Following a discussion with the Mono County Sheriff and Mono County District

Attorney, the Superior Court Judges of the Mono County Superior Court adopt the 2025 Mono
